Read the two chapters together as a family. Read Luke 1 first, then Matthew 1.

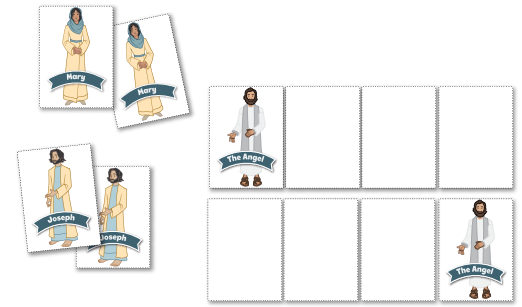
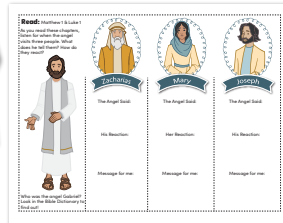
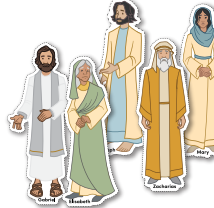
### Small Children:

### Everyone:

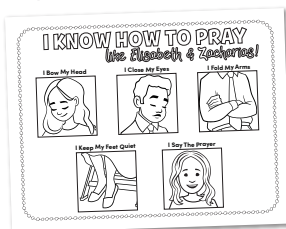
Play Memory with the cards included (print twice)! If you get a match, talk about what that person did in the scriptures you read today.

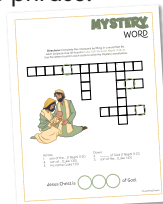
### Small Children:

Read Luke 1:35. Then hand a family member the cut out of baby Jesus in the manger. Help them repeat the phrase "Jesus Christ is the Son of God." Keep passing the cut out around until each family member has had an opportunity to repeat the phrase.



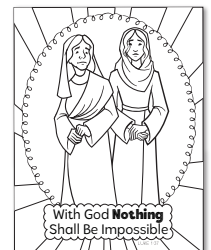
### Older Children/Teens:

Give each family member a crossword puzzle. Invite them to complete the "Mystery Word" crossword by filling in a word on the crossword boxes that fit each scripture clue. The answers are all names or titles of Jesus Christ found in Luke 1:30-35 and 1 Nephi 11:18-21. They will use the letters found in each circle to solve the Mystery word/phrase shared on the bottom of the paper. [SON]



## Activity 4

### Small Children:

On the following page, we have included a new *Come, Follow Me* resource. Our Quick Study page will be a great addition for your family to help you stay on track this year in the scriptures!

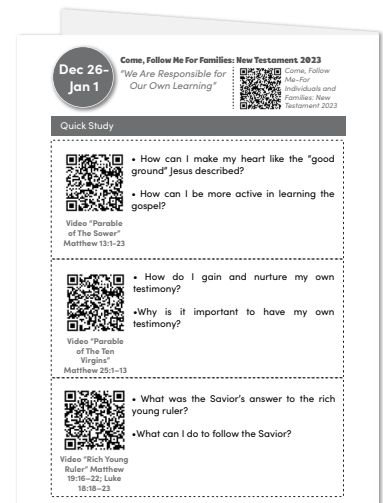
